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NORMAS DE LOS APOYOS INSTITUCIONALES A PROYECTOS DE INVESTIGACION

1. The applicant/intern shall present in writing to the Fundación Branger, any and all information that may be required to evaluate the application according to the applicant's personal, educational, and professional background, and the approval or rejection of said internship application shall be communicated to the applicant in writing.
2. The applicant/intern guarantees the normal execution and completion of the internship work initiated as described in the Internship-Request for Institutional Support application. In the same manner, he/she guarantees that he/she will not interfere at any time with the other activities at Hato Piñero in order to maintain an environment of cooperation and harmony.
3. Accommodations are to take place at the installations of the biological station of Hato Piñero, in accordance to the norms established for their use.
4. The applicant/intern agrees to present information reports in writing to the Fundación Branger, through his/her designated guide which will supervise and evaluate his/her progress, and a final report at a mutually agreed timetable.
5. The applicant/intern agrees to participate in workshops or seminars related to the objectives of the internship with Hato Piñero's staff, or members of other previously arranged groups by the Fundación Branger, as a compensation for the support provided by it, and as a way to share knowledge and ideas. These activities will take form as the work/project develops, and their methodology and timetable shall be mutually agreed upon by both parties.
6. The applicant/intern is not allowed to participate in work, research, or other activities not included in the approved Internship-Request for Institutional Support application.
7. The applicant/intern shall not include other participants in the on-going internship by his/her own initiative, without prior written consent from the Fundación Branger.
8. The applicant/intern agrees to obey the guidelines and regulations concerning conservation and ecological preservation as they are represented in Venezuela, as well as internationally.
9. Developments.
 - a. Definition. "Developments" include, without limitation, ideas, concepts, discoveries, inventions, developments, know-how, patent rights, trade secrets, techniques, methodologies, modifications, innovations, improvements, writings, documentation, data and other rights (whether or not protectible under patent, trademark, copyright or similar laws) resulting from the applicant's studies at Hato Piñero or relating to the use of indigenous species or samples taken therefrom (including, without limitation, biological materials or information derived therefrom) collected by the applicant/intern at Hato Piñero, which are conceived, discovered, invented, developed, created, made or reduced to practice by the applicant/intern during or following his/her visit to Hato Piñero.
 - b. Joint Ownership. As a condition for allowing the applicant/intern right to conduct biological, ecological and/or other scientific research at Hato Piñero, all Developments shall be jointly owned by Hato Piñero and the applicant/intern. In order to establish Hato Piñero's joint ownership, the applicant/intern assigns to Hato Piñero an undivided one-half interest in and to the Developments.
 - c. Option for License. The applicant/intern grants to Hato Piñero a first option to execute an exclusive, worldwide, royalty-bearing commercialization license, with the right to grant sublicenses, to Hato Piñero's undivided one-half interest in the Developments, to make, have made, use, sell or distribute, or otherwise commercialize the Developments, on commercially reasonable terms to be negotiated by the parties in good faith.
10. The applicant/intern agrees to indemnify the Fundación Branger in case any ecological damage, infrastructure degradation, loss or misappropriation of material and tools is incurred due to the work/research internship, or direct or indirect participation of the applicant or his/her staff.
